Overview of funding schemes in programme

Funding Scheme	Approx Funding allocated	Max. % of co-funding	No. of participants*
Projects	€100,000 - €2.5m	60/80	>1 (no min)**
Conference grants	€100,000	50	1
Operating grants	€40,000 - €600,000	60/80	1

* Eligible countries: EU 27 +Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway (Croatia subject to MOU)

** Proposals focusing on national/regional interest only will be rejected
