Figure 2.2 People registered by degree of intellectual disability and by age group, NIDD 2017

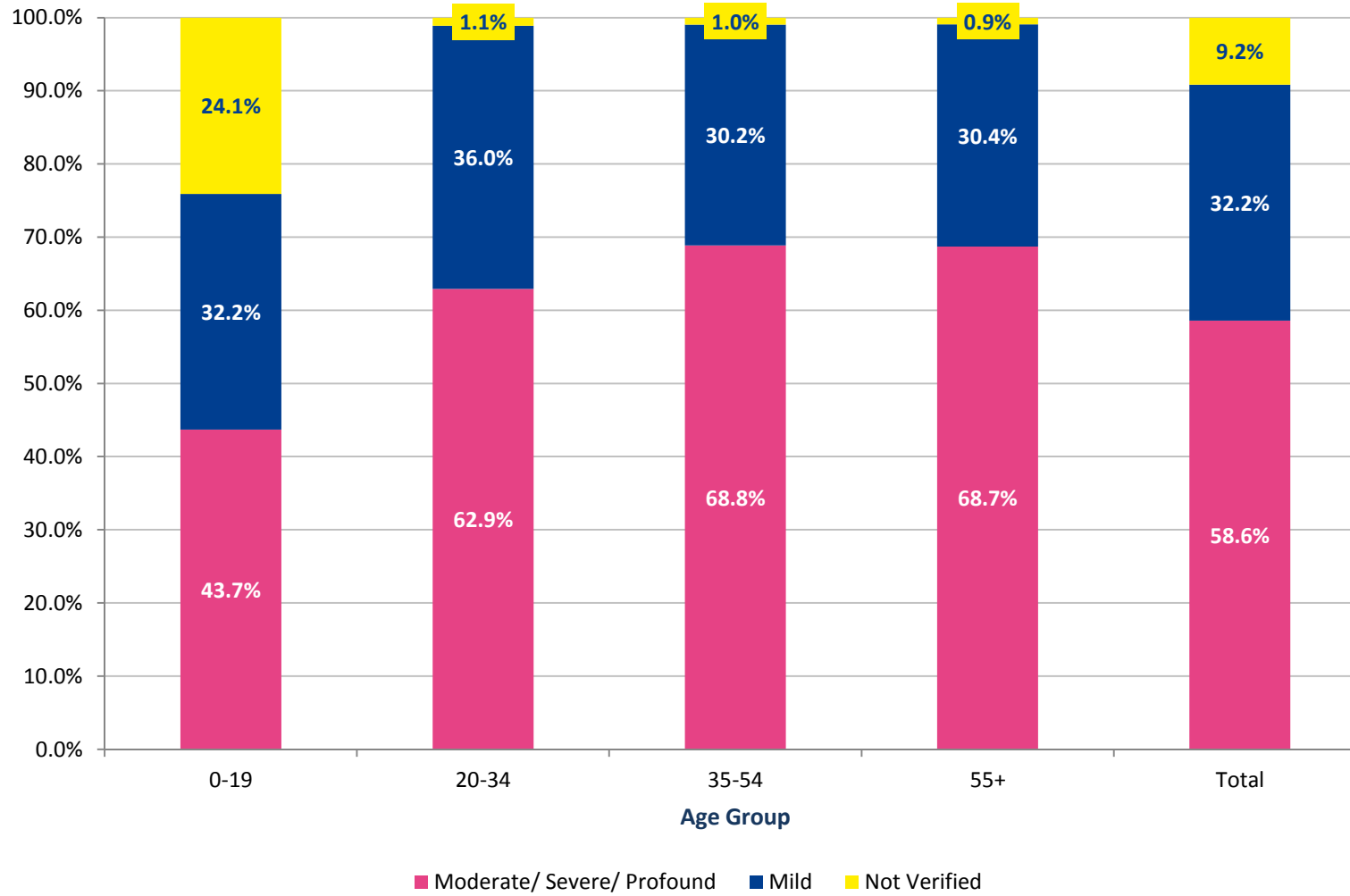


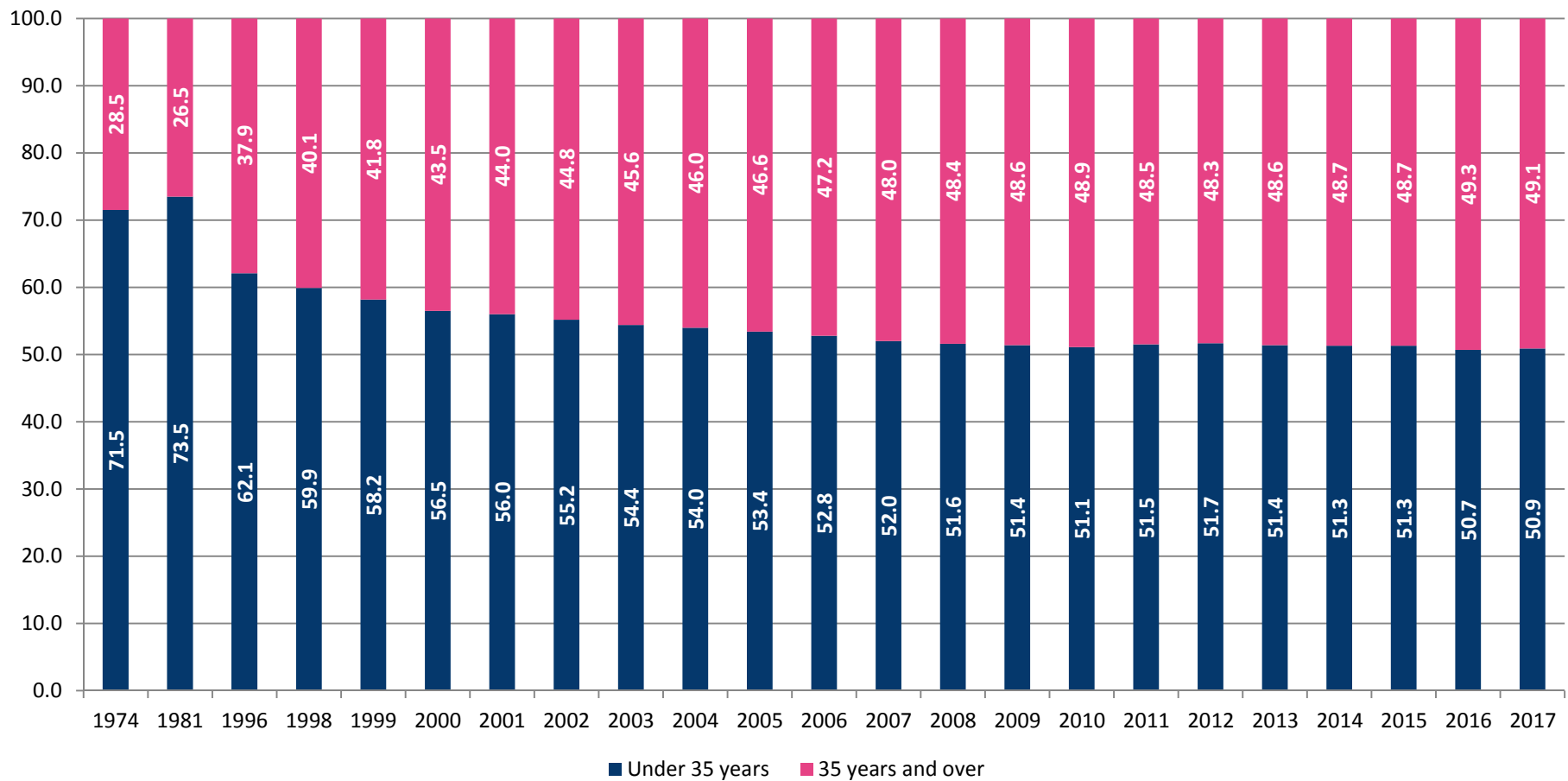

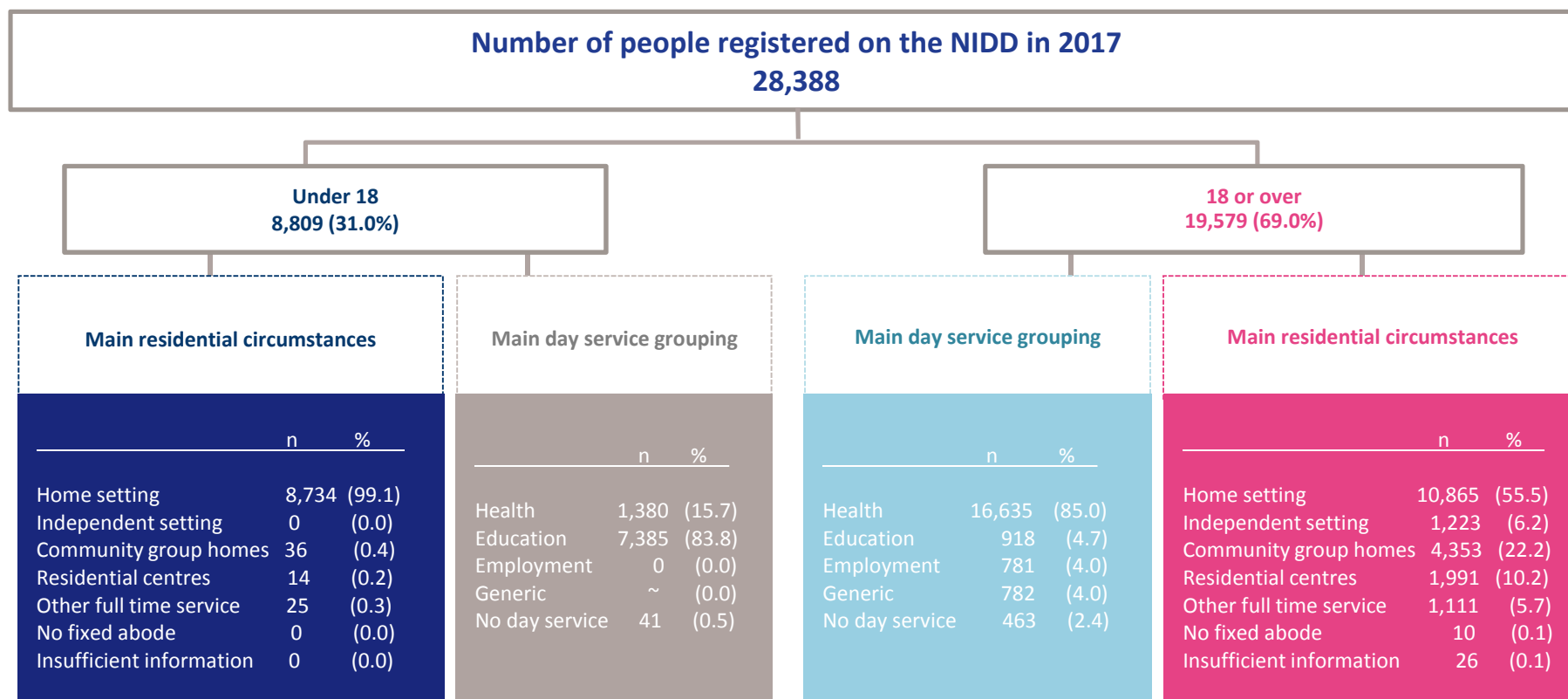

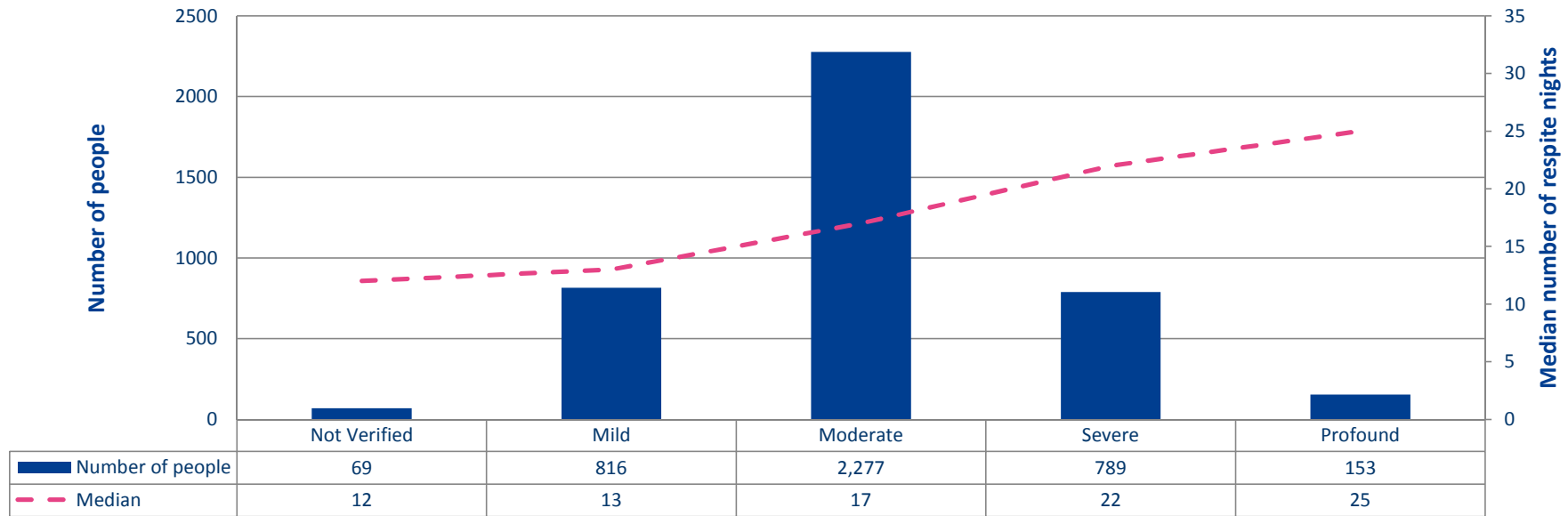

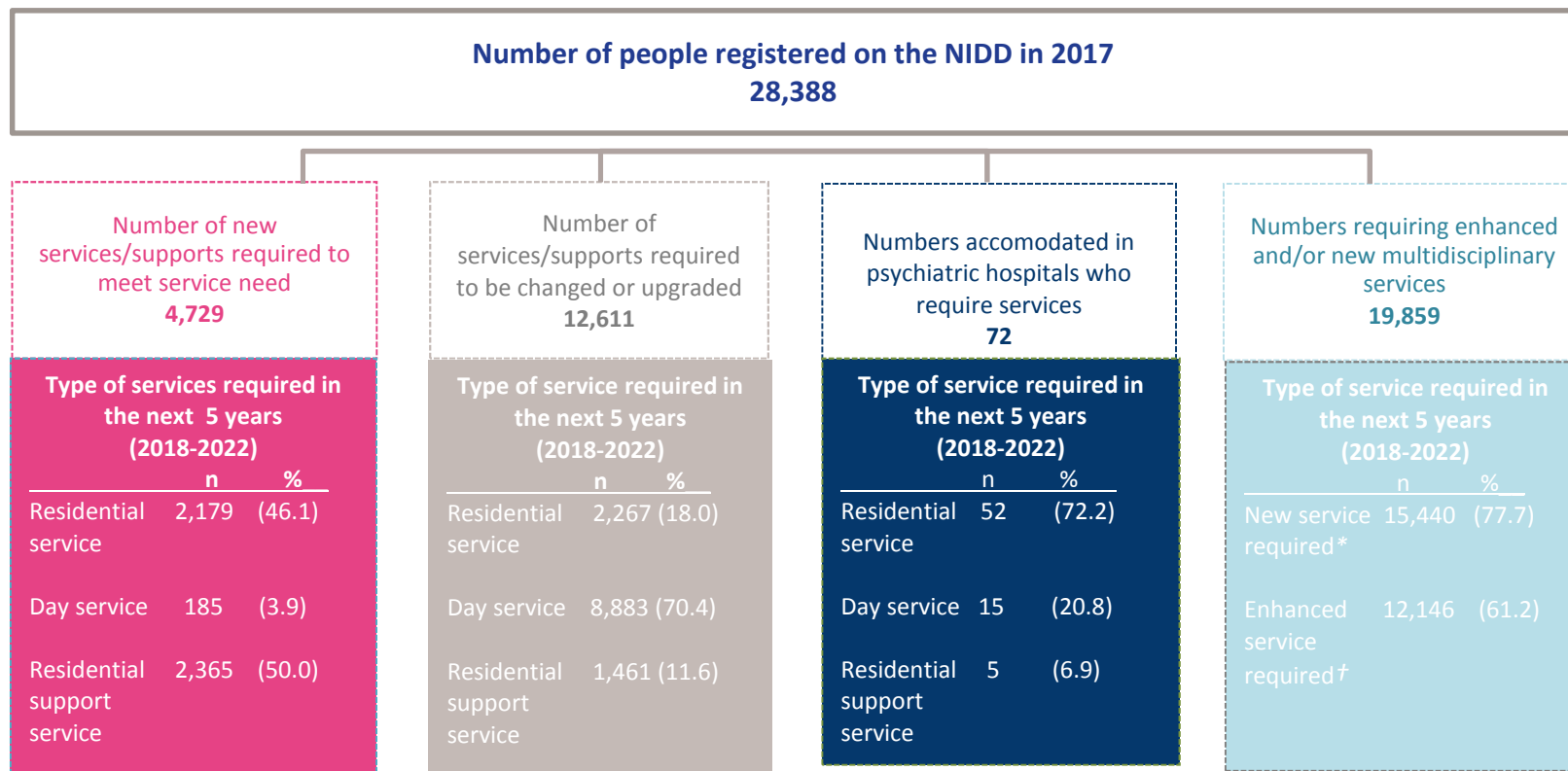

Figure 4.2 Unmet need - number of people requiring residential service or residential support service by age group 2018-2022, NIDD 2017

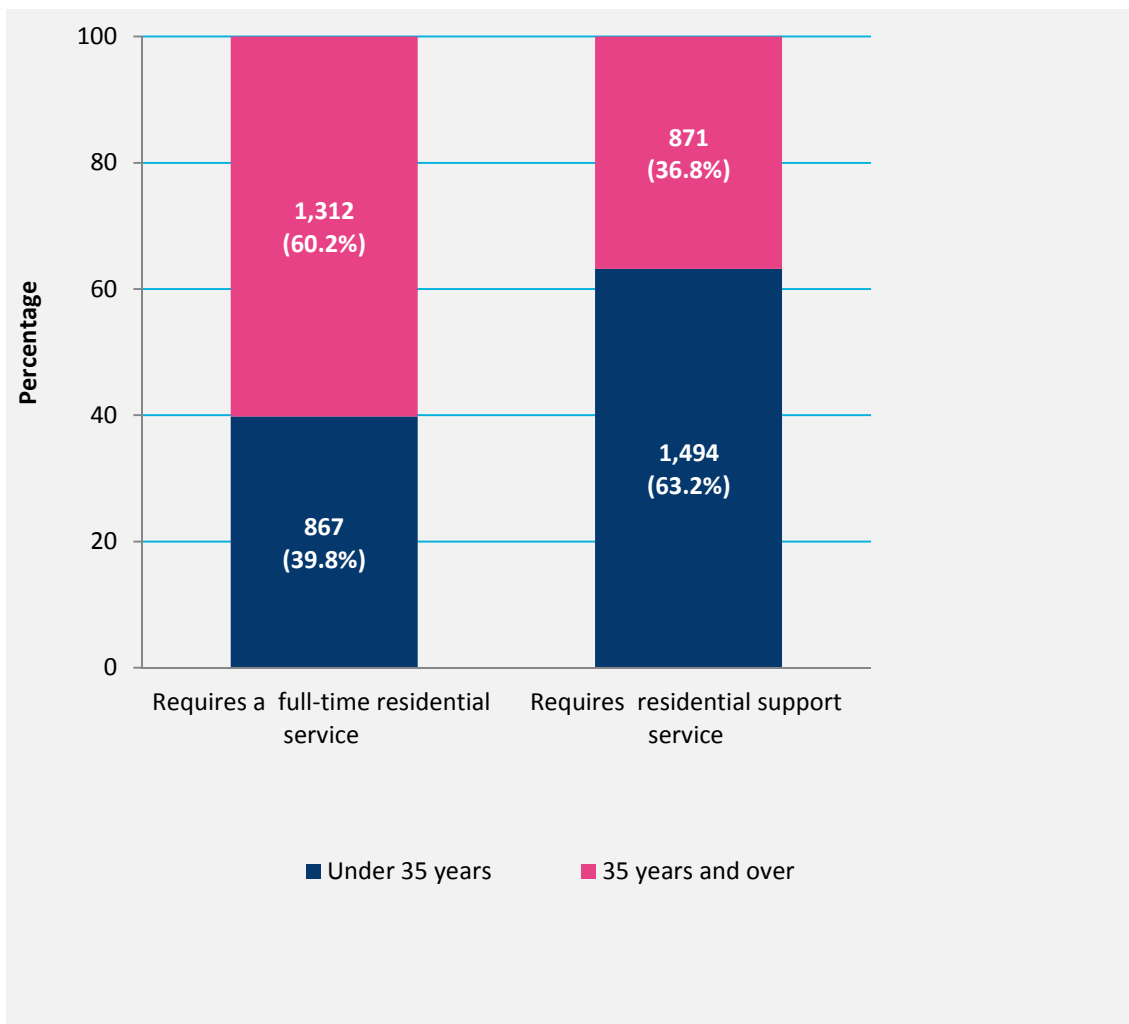
