ACCUMULATED ON CENSUS NIGHT FOR ALL PATIENTS



WERE NEW LONG-STAY, i.e. had been in hospital continuously for between one and five years.



WERE OLD LONG-STAY, i.e. had been in hospital for five years or more.



THE AVERAGE LENGTH OF STAY ON CENSUS NIGHT WAS 1,406.67 DAYS (MEDIAN 76 DAYS).
