

**Notes**: During the review and update period prior to the 2017 extract of data from the NIDD, 724 people were removed from the database and there were 769 new registrations, the largest proportion of these in the 0–9-year age group. The age and gender distribution by degree of intellectual disability of those registered on the database is summarised in Table 2.1, which shows the corresponding prevalence rates per thousand of the population.



Figure 3.2 Number of people in receipt of respite nights and median number of respite nights received, by degree of intellectual disability, NIDD 2017





Figure 4.2 Unmet need - number of people requiring residential service or residential support service by age group 2018-2022, NIDD 2017


