## Data submissions to the HRB NPIRS

1. Data for the NPIRS are returned quarterly to the NPIRS Team in the HRB according to agreed specifications. The files are coded and processed in the HRB and when ready, are uploaded using the 3rd party upload function in LINK (LINK is the HRB IT platform for NPIRS data collection).

2. A report is prepared for the uploaded data for the relevant time period, e.g. Q1 2020. This report is sent to the NPIRS contact in each hospital for approval and verification purposes. A signed report is returned to the HRB indicating the hospital's agreement with the report details for the time period outlined. The data for acute units is prepared for the Quarterly Performance Indicator Report (PIs) for the HSE and these reports are distributed quarterly to the HSE and the Department of Health. At the end of each year the data from all units and hospitals is compiled into the annual Activities of Irish Psychiatric Units and Hospitals report.

3. Data files received and uploaded are subjected to numerous in-built quality assurance checks and following these the NPIRS Team may need to contact you to verify data. Where data has been returned with incomplete fields, it will be necessary to contact you to obtain this missing information.

[4. Please note that some fields in the NPIRS database on LINK are auto-calculated which means they are calculated/filled based on what is entered in the relevant related field on the original data file submitted. Therefore, if incomplete data is submitted for these fields it may not be possible to code some data items. You may notice also that some items appear in this manual that are not on the template. These items such as CHO, LHO, occupation code etc may be automatically coded based on the entries in the fields related to these particular items. Please see the tab Auto calculated fields.](#)

5. Data collected include demographic data relating to each patient such as sex, marital status, ethnicity, country of birth and date of birth, along with clinical and diagnostic information such as date of admission/discharge, legal category, and order of admission, diagnosis on admission and discharge and reason for discharge. Data received from units and hospitals for the NPIRS are subjected to various in-built and manual quality assurance and validation measures, according to policies and procedures employed by the NPIRS Team. Data are cleaned and validated upon receipt and import of data into the database, prior to the return of quarterly status reports to units and hospitals, prior to the return of annual status reports, and at year end in preparation for this report. All units and hospitals are required to sign off on final admission and discharge data for the year in advance of the preparation of this report.

Data for Q1 January to March of any given year must be returned to the HRB by the end of April of that year, i.e., one month later.

Data for Q2 April to June of any given year must be returned to the HRB by the end of July of that year, i.e., one month later.

Data for Q3 July to September of any given year must be returned to the HRB by the end of October of that year, i.e., one month later.

Data for Q4 October to December of any given year must be returned to the HRB by the end of January of the next year, i.e., one month later.

**Data should be returned to [npirs@hrb.ie](mailto:npirs@hrb.ie) using the NPIRS Admission/Discharge Template and the cover sheet on this template should be completed.**

**Do not return the data file to the email address of individual staff members as other members of the team do not have access to their emails if they are on leave.**

**DO NOT return names of patients or names of next of kin, GP details, medical card numbers or PPS numbers as this is a breach under GDPR and will have to be reported to the Data Protection Officer (DPO) in the HRB, who in turn, may have to report it to the Data Protection Commissioner.**

Please upload the file to the secure portal Ctera Savenet as per instructions in the document **Procedures for managing files on CTERA.docx**. Please email [npirs@hrb.ie](mailto:npirs@hrb.ie) to inform the team that you have uploaded the data. Please use this email address for all queries in relation to your hospital's data.

**If for any reason there is a delay in returning the data file to the HRB please let us know asap so as we can note it and follow up as appropriate. If we do not receive data by the requested deadline the HRB will inform the office of the Head of Service for Mental Health in the relevant CHO area and/or follow up with the Clinical Director of the approved centre.**

Please note the following in relation to **Transfers**:

NPIRS does not collect transfers to and from approved centres. If a patient moves from one centre to another, this patient must be discharged from the first centre and admitted to the other. While this may be seen as double counting or losing a length of stay, it needs to be borne in mind that the primary focus of NPIRS is on capturing activity within the services as opposed to episodes of care. Please apply this rule also to involuntary patients, who legally remain in the care of the unit to which they have been admitted.

If a patient is transferred to a general hospital for medical treatment, do not submit a discharge for this patient as the patient remains a patient of the approved centre until his/her return to the approved centre. In the event that such a patient does not return to the approved centre due to death occurring in the general hospital, please enter the date of discharge/death as the date of death of the patient in the general hospital.

**Please note the following re Deaths:**

If a patient dies while on leave or in another hospital (for medical/other treatment) and this patient remains a patient of your unit/hospital and/or a bed is held open for them, this should be returned as a death for NPIRS even though the death did not occur in your unit/approved centre.

Once the patient is still considered an **inpatient** and **under the care of the inpatient services** all deaths should be returned to us regardless of where that death occurred.

In addition, if the patient dies while AWOL this should also be returned as a death to NPIRS.

If the MHC has been notified of the death of a patient while they remain an **inpatient or resident** of the approved centre NPIRS should also receive a record of this death. Thus, the number of deaths returned to NPIRS for your unit/hospital should tally with that returned to the MHC for **inpatients**.

### Please note the following in relation to Involuntary admissions:

For those persons who present for admission with Forms 1 to 5 please complete an admission record dated to the day of presentation, but delay entering legal status until the consultant psychiatrist has made a decision to make an admission order or to admit voluntarily so that legal status may be entered retrospectively. This should take place within 24 hours of the admission. If the admission order is made please keep the original date of admission for the patient and enter the legal status as involuntary.

In the event that the person is not admitted and leaves because the consultant does not consider admission necessary please note the number of these events. In this instance it is sufficient to simply provide the HRB with a head count of these admissions when submitting the quarterly download. For example, indicate '*There were X admissions who presented with Forms 1 to Form 5 but were not admitted by the consultant*' on the email accompanying the download.

### Please note the following re Ward of court:

Since 26 April 2023, applications for adults to become a Ward of Court can no longer be made. The enactment of the Assisted Decision-Making (Capacity) Act 2015 ended applications to be made a ward of court from 26 April 2023. This new law provides a detailed legal framework for people who need help to make decisions about their welfare, property and other affairs and who previously may have been made a Ward of Court. The Act introduces new guiding principles about interacting with a person who has difficulties with their decision-making capacity and establishes a system of decision support arrangements for these people. Everyone who is currently a ward of court will have their decision-making capacity assessed. The courts will decide whether or not they need a decision supporter.

Over the next 3 years, adult wards of court will have their cases reviewed by the court and will move over to a new decision support arrangement, if necessary. An application can be made to court by the ward, the ward's committee or a close relative or friend to have the case reviewed more quickly.

Within three years, all adult wards of court will be brought under the new legal framework. If a ward is still a child after that three year period, the decision-making capacity review will happen within six months of turning 18.
